TLM (Teaching Learning Material) Competition will be organized for teachers as part of 'Navin Asher Kazi Awards for Excellence in Teaching 2023'.

Teaching Learning Materials are vital for effective education as they facilitate the understanding of the concepts better. They help students acquire information better and enhance their retention. They also stimulate creativity and imagination, encouraging learners to think beyond the textbook and come up with their own distinct ideas and solutions.

Those who wish to participate in the competition will be invited to give a presentation on the TLM which they have created and how it will help in elucidating the concept under discussion.

The competition will be held in two categories:

1. Physically constructed aids
2. Digitally developed aids

All teachers under the Indian School Visa are eligible to participate in this competition. There are no restrictions on the years of teaching experience.

Criteria of Evaluation:

- Originality – 20 marks
- Engaging – 10 marks
- Relevance – 10 marks
- Promoting Critical Thinking – 10 marks
- Encouraging Active Learning – 10 marks

Originality – plagiarized TLMs will be rejected outright. The material presented should be conceptualized by the participant; materials used elsewhere by any other person / organization / media, etc. will not be accepted.

Engaging – how the TLM engages the students and making their learning more interesting and enhances their motivation to learn.

Relevance – how the TLM equips students with vital resources to understand a concept.

Promoting Critical Thinking – how the TLM presents the students with the real world scenario and how it enables the students to apply knowledge in the real life situations.

Encouraging Active Learning – how the TLM provides opportunities for group work and discussions for collaborative learning.
